

Notice of Change in IPA's Interconnection Process

Overview of IPA Cluster Study Process Transition

- Intermountain Power Agency (IPA) has adopted new Generator Interconnection Procedures and transitional procedures (*Process for Transitioning to "First-Ready, First Served" Interconnection Queue Procedures*) that became effective April 1, 2026. As part of this change, IPA has transitioned from a serialized study approach to a cluster generator interconnection approach.
- The Transitional Cluster window opens on April 1, 2026.
- The Transition Cluster Window will be open to new applications until May 12, 2026. Following this date, the next phase of new applications would proceed under the cluster interconnection process, expected opening on April 1, 2027.

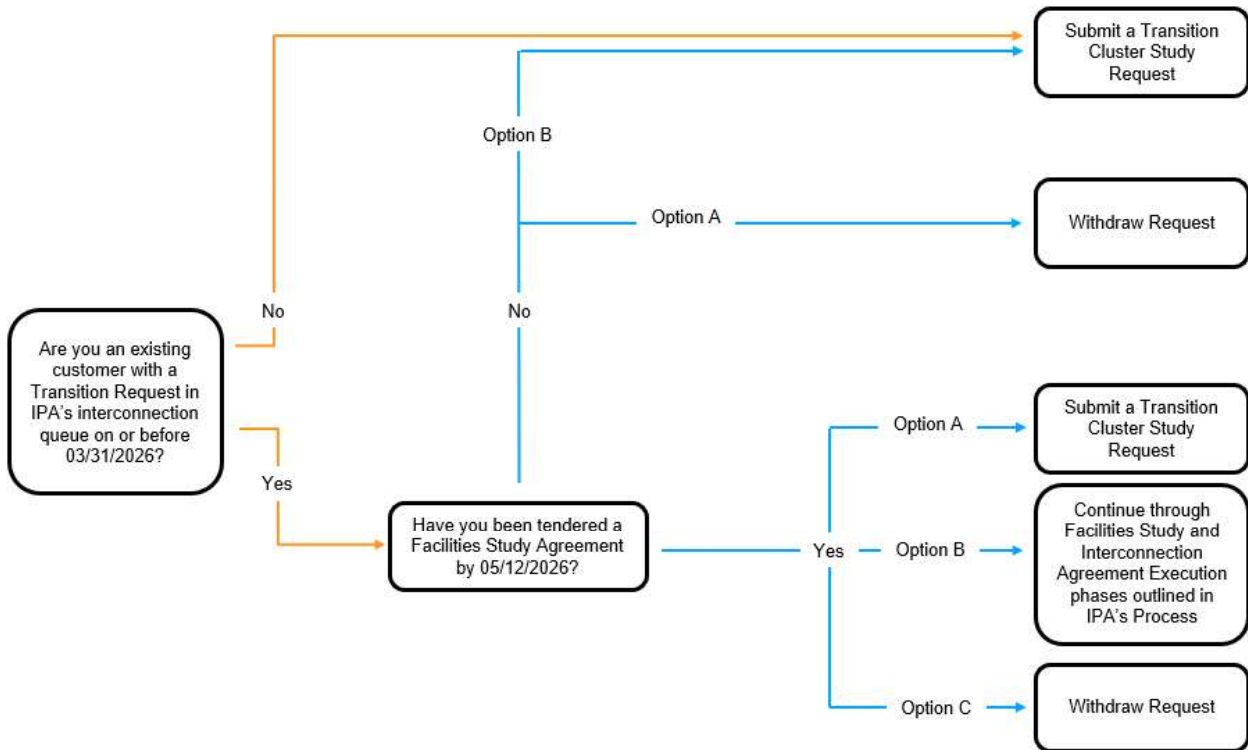
Impact on Existing Customers

- Customers currently in the generator interconnection serial interconnection queue with IPA by March 31, 2026, the "Effective Date," may apply for a Transition Request, placing them in the Transition Study Queue.
- Customers with a Transition Request who, 30 business days after the Effective Date, have received a Facilities Study Agreement but not executed an Interconnection Agreement, ("Late-Stage Transition Request"), are not required to enter the Transition Cluster process.
- All other customers who are not eligible for Late-Stage Transition Requests may choose to either move into the Transition Study Request Queue or withdraw their existing requests.

Late-Stage Transition Requests

- Customers with Late-Stage Transition Requests may choose one of the following options:
 - a. Continue with the Facilities Study and Interconnection Agreement as part of the Transition Cluster Study
Requirement: Demonstration of Site Control and completion of Readiness Milestone required for execution of Interconnection Agreement with IPA.
 - b. Opt-in to the Transition Cluster Process, thereby forfeiting any previous Interconnection Study results or Interconnection Study Agreements, as well as any previously tendered, but unexecuted, Interconnection Agreements.
Requirement: Written notification to IPA on or before June 25, 2026.

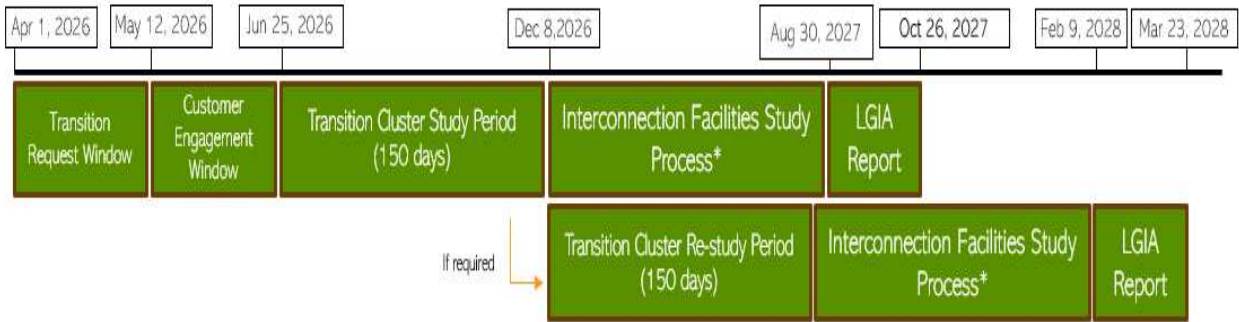
Existing Customer Transition Request Flowchart



Application Requirements (Starting April 1, 2026)

- The window for Interconnection Customers to submit Interconnection Requests to be included in the Transition Process is from April 1, 2026 to May 12, 2026 (the Transition Close Date).
- Interconnection Customers must demonstrate the requirements outlined in IPA *Process for Transitioning to "First-Ready, First Served" Interconnection Queue Procedures* by June 25, 2026 (the Transition Readiness Deadline).

Implementation Schedule and Key Milestones



* The Facilities Study process can be executed with different levels of accuracy with respect to the cost estimation. A +/- 10% accuracy will likely require more time than a +/-20% accuracy. The timeline reflects the +/-10% accuracy

** Target dates are estimates based on timelines presented in the IPA LGIP processes and are subject to change. Every project is unique, and changes could be made that impact schedules.*

Key Initial Dates:

- April 1. – Transition Request Window opens
- May 12. – Transition Request Window closes
- June 25. – Deadline to demonstrate transition request requirements
- June 25. – Deadline for qualifying Late-Stage Transition Requests

All dates are preliminary and subject to change.

The number of restudies is dependent on withdrawals from the process and can be more than 1.
